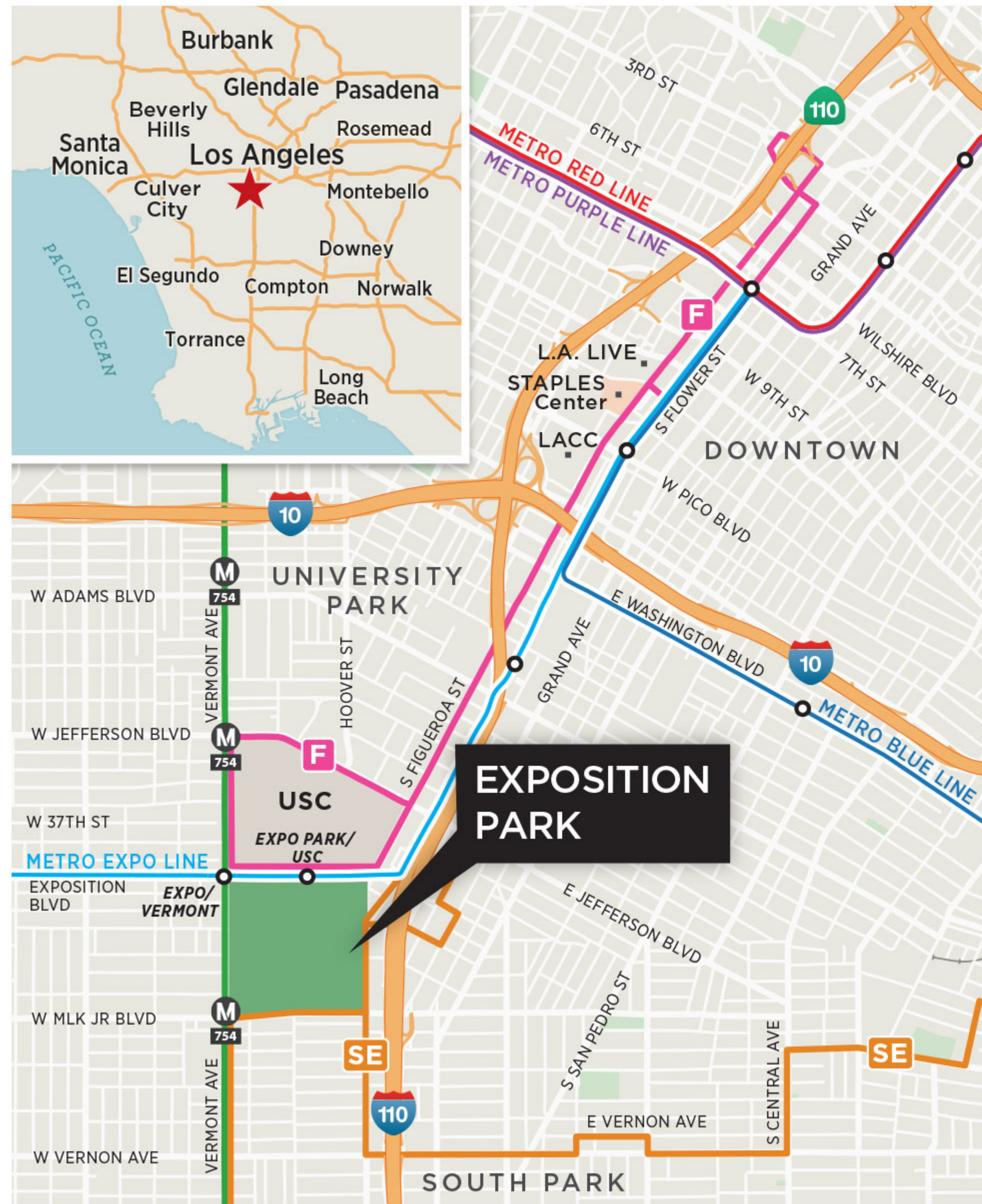


EXPOSITION PARK

THE CROSSROADS OF THE LOS ANGELES COMMUNITY



Exposition Park lies directly to the west of the Harbor Freeway (I-110) and 1.5 miles to the south of the Santa Monica Freeway (I-10) at the southerly end of Downtown Los Angeles.

Directions

By car:
 From the North: Take Exposition Boulevard or Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard southbound off-ramps from I-110 freeway.
 From the South: Take Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard or 37th Street northbound off-ramps from I-110 freeway.

By DASH bus:
 From Downtown Los Angeles, take the [F] DASH line.
 From South Los Angeles and via the Metro Blue Line at the Slauson Avenue Station take the [SE] DASH Southeast line.

By Metro Rapid bus:
 Take the [754] Hollywood-Athens line via Vermont Ave.
 For further information on routes, fares and schedules call: 1.800.COMMUTE

By Metro Expo line:
 From Downtown Los Angeles, take the Westbound Expo line.
 From West Los Angeles, take the Eastbound Expo line.

Angel's Walk

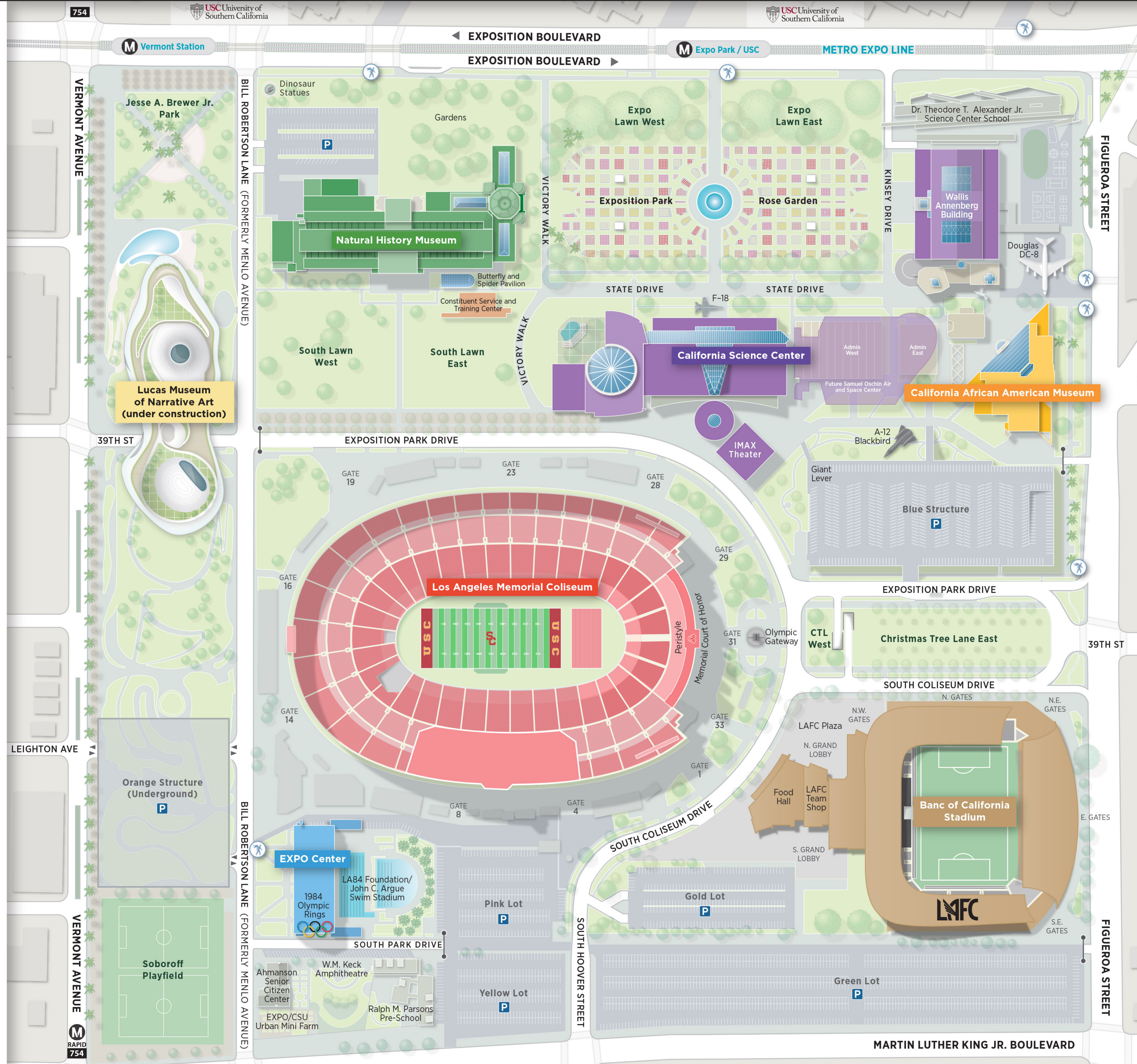
Cultural and historic sites along this self-guided Walk are referenced by on-street stanchions as on the map.
